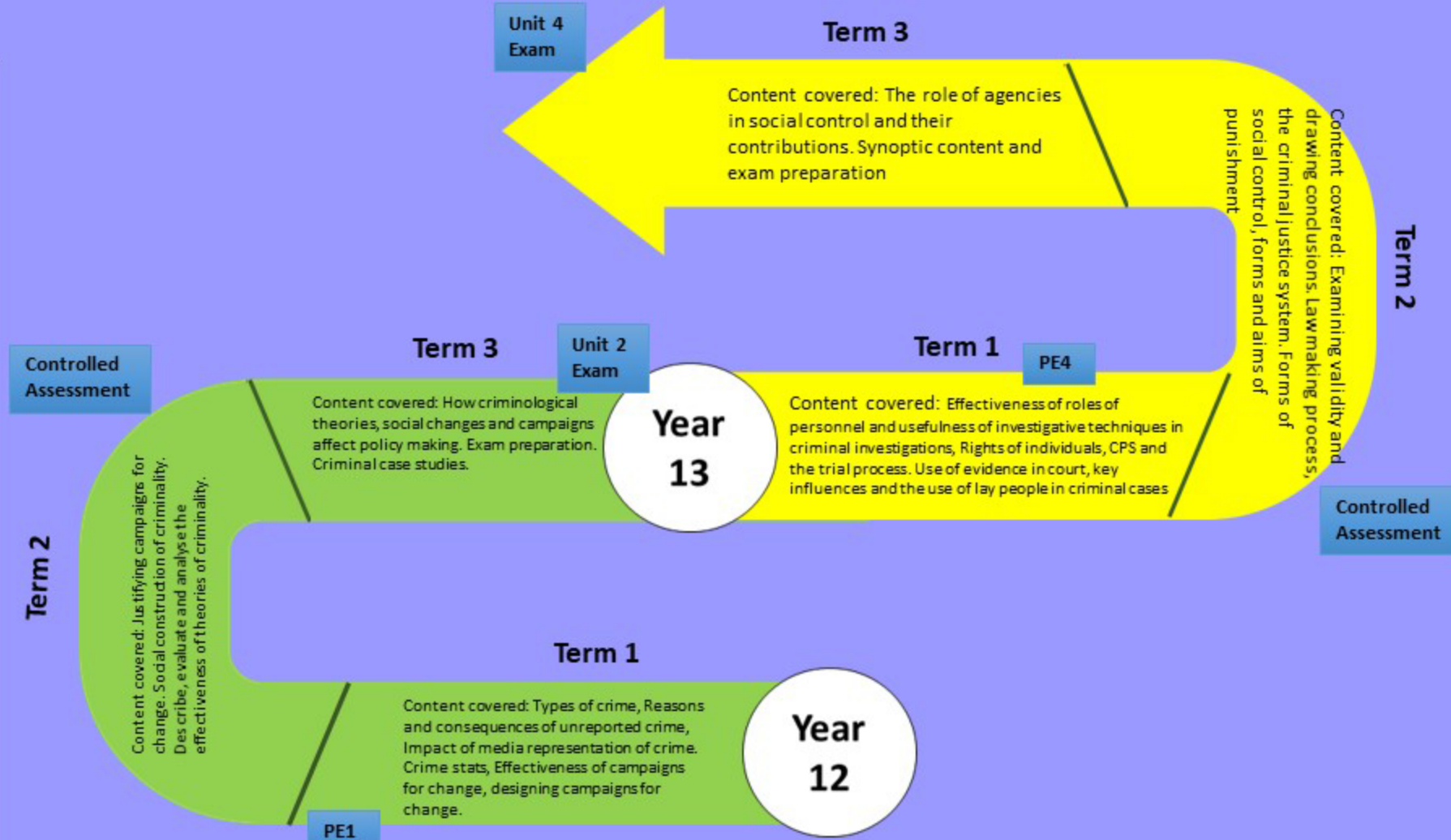
Intent

Key Stage 5

Pupils will be taught to:

- Understand how campaigns are used to elicit change
- Plan campaigns for change relating to crime
- Understand social constructions and theories of criminality
- Understand the causes of criminality and policy change
- Understand the process of criminal investigations and the prosecution of suspects
- Be able to review criminal cases
- Understand the criminal justice system in England and Wales
- Understand the role of punishment in a criminal justice system
- Understand measures used in social control
