

Phase 1 Objective

- In principle, the school have agreed to replace the pitch next summer at a cost of c£360,000
 (to be ratified at the next full governors' meeting)
- To raise £75,000 across an 12 month period
 July 2019 July 2020 to support the funding of the replacement pitch
- PTSA to support & drive the immediate agenda
 & create a continuous improvement plan
