Hints & Tips

2. If you are struggling for inspiration then you could find an image on the internet or in a book to copy.

Once you've got an image in mind, you can draw/paint it straight on to the loo roll or you could draw a light / rough guide to what you want to draw before starting.



1. You will need:
- Loo roll
 - Basic drawing or painting equipment
 - Possibly an image for inspiration



3. Don't forget this is a three-dimensional piece of art, your drawing / painting should stretch at least two thirds of the way around, if not all the way around! Consider your full composition before you start.

4. Don't forget to be resourceful....even with a basic biro pen you can apply tone and shade with cross-hatching. If you want to paint but don't have any paints, what about using tea / coffee for staining or use food colouring?



5. Above all...have **FUN & ENJOY!**

Perhaps you want to make....this might get you started.

- Google search 'things made from toilet rolls' or '3d art made from toilet rolls' or 'sculpture made from toilet rolls' for inspiration and some instructions, or, just use your own creativity.
- If you do not have glue, remember you can cut slots to join card together.
