Aims of AR


- Programme for students with the aim to create culture of reading within school
- To accelerate reading progress of students on the programme
- To measure and track reading growth over time
- To make students more confident readers and therefore better writers and communicators

AR in action

- STAR reading test
- 2. Based on reading test each student given a 'zone of development'
- 3. All Year 7s take out book from LRC within their zone
- 4. Reading time each Thurs and Fri am session; 30 mins per week in English; homework
- 5. Students take an AR quiz after each book read
- 6. Progress tracked and measured via quiz results and reading assessments


