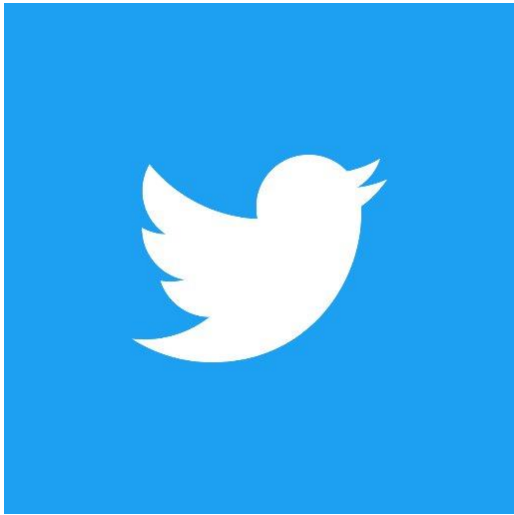

# Mobile Phone policy

During lessons and movement between lessons	At break and lunch
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Switched off and out of sight in bag or blazer</li> <li>No music, no headphones</li> <li>If seen in lessons or movement time – confiscation with no debate!</li> <li>Same applies in form time and PSHCE</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students may use phones at break and lunch for music, gaming, communication and social media</li> <li>No photos or filming</li> <li>Abuse via phone will lead to sanction and parents being contacted</li> </ul>
Confiscation	Sanctions
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any breach of policy = confiscation by staff</li> <li>All confiscations are for the remainder of the day</li> <li>Staff provided with envelopes, phone placed inside, sealed, time, date and student name on envelope</li> <li>Phone taken to year group office, incident logged - phone to be collected by student at 3.05pm</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Level 1 – first offence: Confiscation until the end of day</li> <li>Level 2 – two-three offences: phone confiscated overnight until the end of the next day</li> <li>Level 3 – four or more offences: phone confiscated, parents required to collect phone from LIM</li> </ul>

# Basic 8 Expectations

1. Arrive on time to school, registration and lessons



# Aims of AR

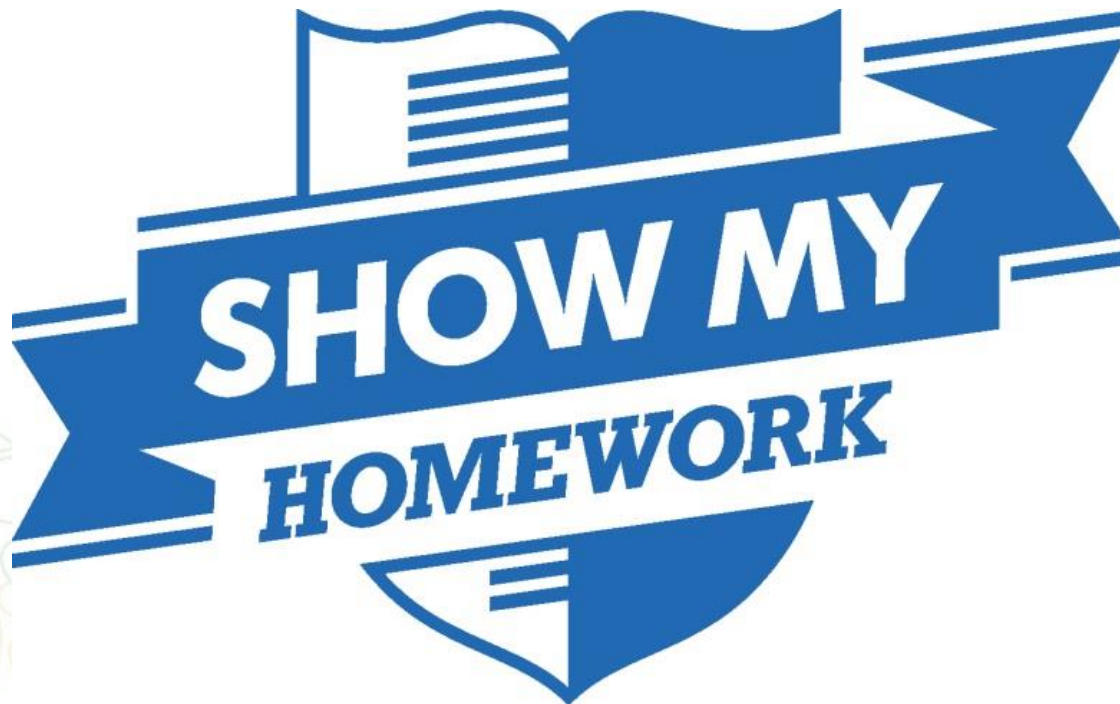
- Programme for students with the aim to create culture of reading within school
  - To accelerate reading progress of students on the programme
  - To measure and track reading growth over time
  - To make students more confident readers and therefore better writers and communicators
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# AR in action



1. STAR reading test
2. Based on reading test – each student given a ‘zone of development’
3. All Year 7s take out book from LRC within their zone
4. Reading time – **each Thurs and Fri am session; 30 mins per week in English; homework**
5. Students take an AR quiz after each book read
6. Progress tracked and measured via quiz results and reading assessments



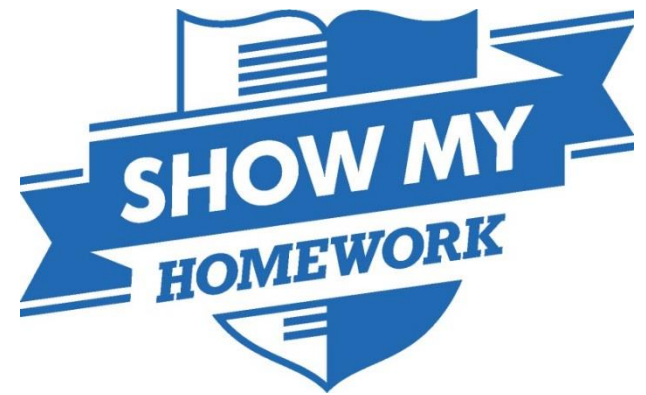

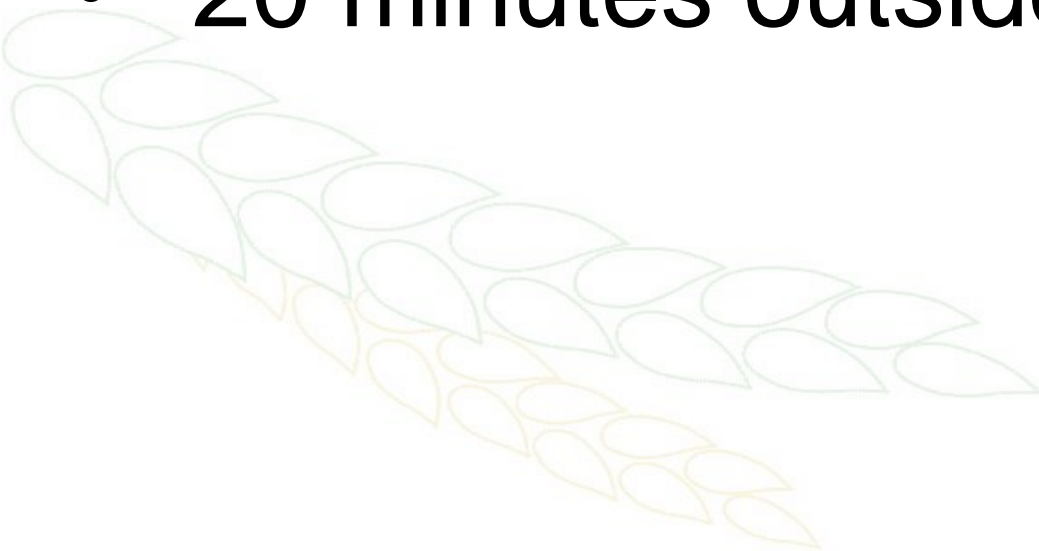
