Assessment

We are still waiting for confirmation of the Government's final plans for the 2021 GCSE Exam series and specifically it's timings.

Due to the two week isolation period we have delayed the Year 11 Academic Review One period to the week after October half term – this is the week beginning **Monday 2nd November 2020**.

The purpose of the assessments is to ensure that the students and the school are aware of any gaps in knowledge. Then the identified gaps in knowledge and skills can be targeted in lessons and extra support.

At the moment we are planning on Year 11 Mock exams being the weeks beginning Monday 8th February 2021 and Monday 22nd February 2021. This places February half term in between the two exams weeks. This plan is obviously contingent on the current climate and any further announcements regarding exams by the Government.



Pathways

Students should start to consider long-term goals as soon as possible.

- We are working to produce opportunities for students to sample their possible sixth form options via some 'Taster' afternoons.
- In these 'Taster' sessions students will be introduced to the subject on offer, the content of the course as well as it's assessment method and how it is delivered at Sandbach Sixth Form.

Revision Skills



 Students will be proactively taught and modelled revision skills in their lessons.

 Those revision skills focus around key concepts such as retrieval practice, spaced practice and interleaving.
