

16-19 Tuition Fund Statement

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is a £96 million one-off fund for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring-fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, Maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted.

Although the actual tuition does not need to be for GCSE English or Maths, the students supported all need to be those who had not achieved grade 4 or above in at least one of those subjects at this level by age 16.

Sandbach School Sixth Form is eligible to receive £1,728 from this fund for small group tuition. We will be using this funding to support students who have not yet achieved a grade 4 in English and/or Maths at GCSE.

This fund will be used to provide English and Maths tuition to small groups of students.

The support offered will be tailored to needs of each individual. Areas for improvement will be identified and clear targets set. Progress and attendance will be monitored on a weekly basis, up to the date of the examinations.

This statement is in line with the Government guidance and has been published to demonstrate how this funding will be utilised in the academic year 2020/21.
