



## National Justice Museum Trip

As part of their Law, Criminology and Psychology courses, students have to study both the justice system and the prison system. To enhance the study of this area, a trip to the National Justice Museum in Nottingham is being arranged. We would like all students studying these social sciences subjects to take part in this trip. The museum is based within a former courthouse which now serves as an educational resource for students and the public.

The trip will take place on Monday 25th November 2024 departing school at 8am and returning no later than 5pm. Transport will be by coach and there will be 3 members of staff accompanying the students during the visit. Students will have the opportunity to take part in a courtroom workshop where they can assume the roles of those involved in a criminal murder trial. There will also be the opportunity to take part in a museum workshop about crime and punishment through time, followed by some free time in the museum.



### **What does the trip include?**

Return coach travel, a courtroom workshop and a museum workshop. Students should also bring a packed lunch with them as there will be time allocated during the visit for students to break for lunch.
