



Keele University Law & Criminology Taster Day Trip

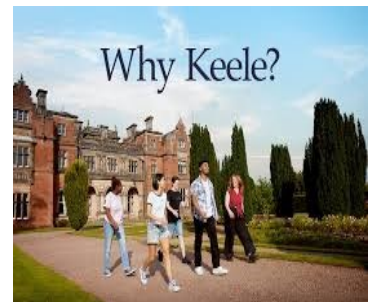

The opportunity has arisen for any students studying Criminology or Law in year 12 to attend Keele University to take part in a series of taster lessons. The day will include guest lectures, University tours, talks from students and some practical workshops. This should give an indication of what further education in these subjects would look like. We are asking that all students take part in this activity to assist them in making a decision regarding their post 18 options.

The trip will take place on Wednesday 5th March 2025 departing school at 8.45am and returning no later than 3.30pm. Transport will be by coach and there will be 2 members of staff accompanying the students during the visit.



What does the trip include?

Return coach travel and a variety of workshops and guest talks from staff and alumni of the University.

Students should also bring a packed lunch with them as there will be time allocated during the visit for students to break for lunch.
