Every 2 years we offer our History and Politics Students the opportunity to head across the Atlantic to sample American culture. Our next visit is planned for February 2026. From the list below you will see some of the details of the trip but the really exciting thing about the visit is being in the city at the heart of World affairs and being able to explore and to see the work of Congress and the Supreme Court close up. There is also the chance to enjoy American food and lifestyle in a very chilled out and interesting city. Each time we have been we have added in new and interesting things to the schedule and have sometimes been very lucky when in Washington (one visit we met MLKs son, another one we saw in the Supreme Court to see the Justices in action and another time we when back to Congress at night to witness a historic vote on Trumps border wall and the budget). It is a tremendously exciting experience, one that the pupils never forget.
